



Escape Kit

The new Deus 3700 Escape Kit allows safe, hands-free evacuation from an elevated work platform. The device is used for self-rescue in case of danger, or for “one after the other” successive escapes, or for safely lowering a casualty to the ground.

The device is simple to use and understand. The purpose-made Deus Super-V 7.5mm rope travels smoothly through the device, automatically limiting the descent speed of the worker. The four dynamic brakes in the unit are unmatched for control and safety. The preset speed of 2 metres per second can be slowed or stopped by turning the brake knob, or by hand control of the rope.

The Deus 3700 is rated for 300 lbs (one person). Unit weighs less than 2½ lbs. Supplied with 50 metres (165ft) or 100 metres (330ft) of rope. Descent training available by Next Safety. ANSI Z359.4.2007.

Before any use of a fall arrest system or a safety net by a worker at a project, the worker’s employer shall develop written procedures for rescuing the worker after his or her fall has been arrested. O. Reg. 145/00, s. 12.

Note: Dialling 911 and waiting for them to rescue a fallen worker is not accepted as a rescue plan. Medical help may be required once the worker has been rescued, but it is your responsibility to plan and carry out the rescue. These kits with training will demonstrate your attention to this requirement and is your easy solution in a bag, like a fall first aid kit.
